**ENTRIES** – Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. They must be received no earlier than opening date & postmarked no later than the closing date. All entries must include payment plus copies of current USEF membership cards for all participating riders, owners, trainers and coaches (if applicable). All riders and owners must show proof of a current USDF number. All horses competing must have at least a USDF HID number unless they are competing only in classes on the exemption list which are not required to have a USDF number. To ride in a USDF GQUAL class, any and all said participants must also be a current participating member (or business member for owners) plus proof that the horse is USEF registered and is Lifetime Registered with the USDF. Each entry must be signed in all applicable places on the back of the entry form. A Negative Coggins, dated within the last entry 12 months is required for Ohio Entries and one dated within six months for out of state entries. Post entries will be accepted if scheduling permits, with an additional \$10.00 per test fee. If scheduling does not allow for additional exhibitors, then a waiting list will be formed to fill any scratches that occur. There will also be a \$10.00 fee when a change is made to an entry after the closing date. A class may be dropped if there are not enough entries for any class.

**AWARDS** – Six ribbons per class. High score ribbons and High Score Voucher awards for Training, First, Second, Third, and Fourth Level will be given. High Score Vouchers are based on the highest score per level for the entire show can be used toward any 2008 WPDA shows or clinics fees. If ribbons are not picked up at the show, they will not be mailed to the winner.

**If entry form is filled out completely and correctly with all the correct cards, Coggins, and documentation required by the USDF/USEF prior to the closed date, a \$5.00 refund will be given when entry is picked up at the show office.**

**\*If you are planning on attending the WPDA Show on Friday and the Grand Haven show on Saturday and Sunday you must pay total stabling, shavings and office fees for both shows on the Grand Haven entry form. If you are attending only the WPDA show, include all fees with this entry form. In the event of a very full show, early-entered riders, competing all three days will get priority consideration.**

**ARENAS/FOOTING** – Indoor arena (80’ x 204’) has shredded leather footing. Due to the lack of space between the arena walls and the dressage ring, riders are permitted to enter the ring, make one pass around the perimeter of the ring, exit, and then enter again for their ride. (Approved by USEF). There are three outdoor rings (in a 325’ x 250’ total area) with all weather footing, plus there are two outdoor warm-up areas (125’ x 226’ & 75’ x 135’) with all weather footing. There is also an outside area with all weather footing for lungeing as well as grass areas. (All weather footing consists of limestone screenings.) Standard arenas will be used for all testing including Training Level and First level tests.

**STABLING** – Grand Haven has 114 permanent box stalls with doors. There are 38 stalls in the main barn, the rest are well-lit, airy show stalls with doors & electric under shelter. Temporary vinyl stalls w/doors will be used if entries warrant. First bag of bedding is provided. Additional bags are available on grounds.

**REFUNDS** – Full refund less office fee prior to closing date with a vet’s certificate. After the closing date, no refunds. Unaccepted post or waiting list entries will get a full refund. If all or part of the competition is canceled due to a storm, accident or other emergency, no entry fees will be refunded.

Take Route 11 north to the Jefferson/Route 307 exit. Head west on Route 307 for 1 mile to East Union Road (First road on Left). Continue 1 mile south on E. Union to Grand Haven Stable on left.

**FROM CLEVELAND:** Take 190 east to Route 11 exit. Go South on Route 11 for 3 exits (to Dorset/Route 307 Exit). Head west on Route 307 for 1 mile to E. Union Road. (First road on Left) Continue 1 mile south on E. Union Street to Grand Haven Stable on left.

**AA** – Open to USEF Adult Amateurs only. Competitor must have reached his or her 21<sup>st</sup> birthday by December 31<sup>st</sup> of the current competition year. ***Must submit a copy of their current USEF Amateur card with entry form.***

**BLM** – Colonel Bengt Ljungquist Memorial Championship Qualifying Class Division

**GQUAL** – Great American Insurance Group/US Dressage Federation Regional Championship Qualifying Class

**TOC** – Test of Choice. Specify on entry form which test will be ridden

- Parking is permitted in assigned areas only. Fire lanes must be kept open
- Medical personnel will be on grounds during competition hours
- **Protective head gear must be worn at all times while mounted**
- Dogs must be on a leash not longer than 6' and attached to a responsible adult. No dogs in the main barn viewing area or in any food service areas
- No smoking in the barns
- Freestyle music: Please supply a CD clearly labeled. It must be delivered to the office at least 2 hours before the start of the class.

### **ATTENTION COMPETITORS**

**EVERY CLASS OFFERED HERIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE SURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THERWITH**

**Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USDF & USEF) for horse, owner, rider, & trainer before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.**

**Show Management reserves the right to limit entries or limit the classes per horse; to refuse any entry or any exhibitor for cause; to disqualify any exhibitor and/or his/her horse for cause; to have horses removed from the grounds for cause; to return any entry and/or stall fee before or during the show for cause; all without being liable for damage or compensation. Management also reserves the right to add, divide or cancel classes, to move classes from on day to the other, to open additional rings & add or vary officials if entries warrant, or make any other changes required by circumstances of the competition.**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violation of this rule will be cause of sanctions against the parent (s) guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. (GR301.5(a))

A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$20 NONMEMBER REGISTRATION FEE AND A \$5 BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE FOR EACH BREED/DISCIPLINE. **FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT**

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

**Federation Release. Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification.**  
**This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.**

- **I AGREE** in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following: **I AGREE** that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").
- **I AGREE** to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.
- **I AGREE** to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.
- **I AGREE** to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and EV113, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while **WARNING** that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.
- If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and **AGREE** to all of the above provisions and **AGREE** to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.
- **I AGREE** that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.
